I. CATEGORY UPDATES:

1. LIFE SCIENCE

a. <u>Define Life Science and Lab Space Ratio</u>: Minimum 50% Life Science/30% (of the 50%) Lab Space

b. <u>Lab Space</u>: defined as wet lab, dry lab, clean room, vivarium, and all lab support rooms.

2. SUBURBAN Mid-Rise

Changed Number of Stories from 6-10 to 6-12

3. PUBLIC ASSEMBLY (NEW for 2024)

a. Included with Mixed-Use Criteria Set

b. Added Other Functions

Examples: Event Space/Meeting space/Galleries/Amphitheaters (including single venues), Courthouses, Education Facilities (which may share a building or campus with other non-public activities.)

4. MIXED-USE

Added Other 10% Function

Examples: Event/Venue Space (weddings, market space, etc.)
Conference Center (available to tenants and public), Outdoor areas
(available to tenants and public such as; pickleball, basketball, etc.)

5. AT LARGE ENTRIES - Not Eligible - this section deleted

At Large entries, entries that are outside the jurisdiction of a local association,

etc. (Eligibility requirements)

7. RENOVATED

Updated Renovation Type:

New, or renovation of, amenity spaces such as fitness center, tenant lounge, conference rooms, roof decks, etc.

6. INDUSTRIAL

- a. Description: More than 5% and less than 50% office.
 - b. Inspection Items Revised such as:
 - i. Removing management office
 - ii. Multi-tenant corridors, stairs, etc.
- c. Other items revised for applicability to Industrial operations.
